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## Introduction

Thank you for choosing FortiClient™ Lite. FortiClient Lite is an easy-to-use, robust tool that helps protect your computer from viruses and malware, provides excellent Parental Controls and gives you a simple-to-use interface to connect to a VPN.

## Installation

Prior to installing FortiClient Lite, please ensure you have uninstalled any previous versions of FortiClient. To install FortiClient Lite, simply double-click the installer program and follow the prompts. You can start the FortiClient Lite user interface by double-clicking the Forti-Client icon on your desktop, or the Fortinet icon in your system tray.

FortiClient Lite supports the following operating systems:

- Microsoft Windows 7 (32-bit and 64-bit)
- Microsoft Windows Vista (32-bit and 64-bit)
- Microsoft Windows XP (32-bit only)

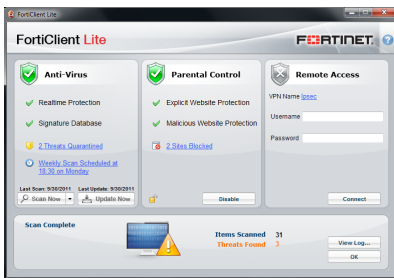
## Using FortiClient Lite

FortiClient Lite offers you real-time live protection from threats to your computer, parental controls and a VPN connection client. Once installed, FortiClient Lite will actively monitor your computer and help prevent infection from potentially harmful software. To initiate a one-time quick scan of your computer for threats, simply click the **Scan Now** button. By clicking the arrow next to the **Scan Now** button, you can select from a **Quick Scan**, **Full Scan** or a **Custom Scan**. **Custom Scan** allows you to select a specific directory or hard drive to scan for potential threats. After selecting your scan type, the scanning progress indicator will become active, allowing you to monitor the current scan.

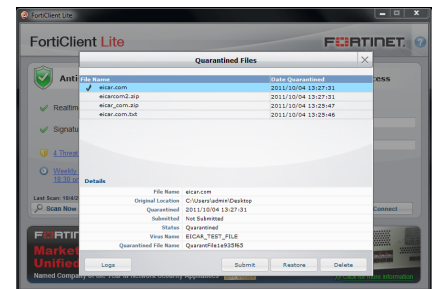


## Detecting and Removing Threats

When your scan is complete, if FortiClient Lite finds a threat, you will see an alert similar to the image below. To eliminate those threats, simply click on the underlined number under “**Threats Detected.**” When you open the Quarantine screen, you will see a list

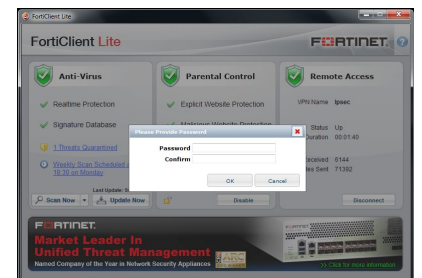


of files FortiClient Lite detected. You can submit them to Fortinet for analysis, restore them from Quarantine if you are certain the file is not a threat, or delete them from your computer entirely.



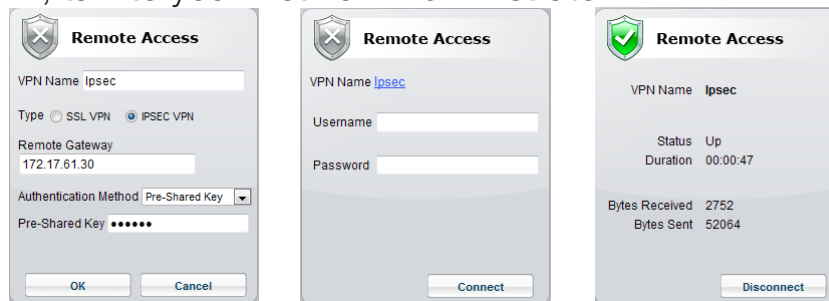
## Using Parental Controls

The Parental Control feature is enabled by default, protecting your computer from potentially hazardous sites. You can simply click the Disable button to switch this feature off. To 'lock' this feature from being disabled, click the lock icon and enter a password. FortiClient Lite will then require this password to disable Parental Controls.



## Using the VPN Client

Virtual Private Networking (VPN) is a way to connect to a network such as your workplace LAN over the Internet. To create a VPN connection, simply fill out the required fields and select 'OK' to save. To connect, enter your username and password. If successful, you will see a 'connected' status screen. If you are unsure of the information you require to connect to your VPN, talk to your Network Administrator.



## Updating FortiClient Lite

Updating FortiClient Lite is automatic. The software contacts Fortinet every three hours to check for threat definition updates and installs them automatically. If you wish to check for an update, simply click the **Update Now** button. FortiClient Lite will then contact Fortinet for a threat definition update.
